A moist sugar with fine, quick dissolving crystals and a golden appearance. The moisture, colour & flavour come from molasses extracted as part of the cane sugar refining process.

Contributing colour, a subtle flavour, texture and a moistness from molasses, soft cane sugars are used widely in domestic, professional and industrial settings.

Soft sugars remain wholesome; virtually indefinitely however they can go hard. Therefore for industrial pack size it is recommended that these are used within two years.

Retailer pack sized product is printed with a two year durability labelling on each pack.

Store in a cool dry place, avoiding extremes in temperature and humidity.
